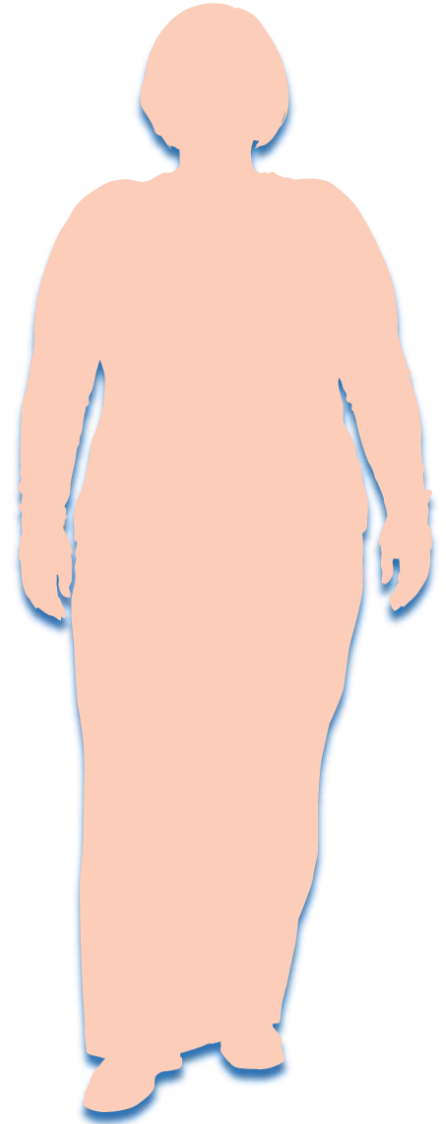


CAML Lambeth Living Well (LLW) service Kathleen* has a new bed

Kathleen was happy to move to new council accommodation after waiting for a long period for suitable accommodation. The new property was unfurnished and she didn't have a bedframe. Combination of low income, trying to deal with multiple debts and the soaring costs of living, had made it impossible for any additional expenditure and therefore had no choice but to sleep on a mattress on the floor. This, in turn, was further impacting physical and mental health with result restricting daily living activities. Kathleen had tried to seek support from Lambeth Household Support Fund, but the application was rejected.

A friend of Kathleen's had seen publicity for CAML's Lambeth Living Well (LLW) Service and suggested she contact CAML. One of our LLW advisers met Kathleen in CAML's Kennington Hub, completed an advice assessment and also grant application for support. Kathleen now has a new comfortable bed, for the first time in over a year is sleeping well and continues to be supported by CAML.
